#### TWINNING FOR PEACE PROJECT

In the framework of the Celebration of the Centenary of the Great War, the Twinning for Peace project intends to *activate a critical dialogue about the "future of Europe"* starting from one of the main question: the relationship with the countries on the southern borders. Uncontrolled migration, terrorism – related danger, illegal traffic of goods and people, but also new commercial partners, cooperation for development, raw materials and different example of productive integration. 

Interrelated borders create a new glimpse: from the union of the four circles (as the involved countries) we build the eye and its twin. An harmonic shape, a twist representing the clear dialogue between different realities, with no conflicts. *People are the milestone of these exchanges*: people who meet in a quite discussion that erases borders. Meeting is also friendship, goes beyond the glimpse, from dialogue a new way of looking to the future grows, a common glimpse of peace and serenity.

A clean and simple image, with no duplicity, an honest glimpse, a symbol and an attraction at the same time. Two eyes witnessing the meeting, a true reciprocal knowledge. In the background, the sea, brushing both Italy and Malta, representing the two sides of the Mediterranean Sea as well as all the 4 countries involved in the project.

The contact point of the 4 circles becomes a unique shape able to irradiate to infinity. An intriguing and attracting shape also from an emotional point of view: it is difficult to resist a glimpse, we are called to give an answer, to react.
